We are delighted to announce that we have a document to help clients comply with the long time battle cry of Dept of Labour or WorkSafe that demands you have a proper list of significant hazards for staff training purposes.

We have developed a list of 125 significant ones and this is followed by another list of 250 and then 500 and then 1000. These are real genuine events that are recorded in a manner that is simple and easy to understand and issue to staff.

You can easily test staff out and ask them to write you a line or two to explain what each rule means so that you can quickly check up on comprehension.

Better still we can do a site inspection for you to find the things that you need to be alerted about so that they do not catch you out. We are sorry to say that the level of knowledge of most officials appears to be abysmal and 99% of sites that have been the subject of a formal visit still have all of the most serious things in the same condition of danger.

This includes hydraulic presses, welding sets and bench grinders plus other plant and racking systems that can be found in most workshops. There are 20 things in the average workshop that can kill you and they must be identified and staff must be trained before they get killed - not afterwards.

DANGER TAG AND LOCKOUT NOTICE

We are pleased to advise that we have purchased another lot of danger tags for issue to sites. Please note that these signs are legally required when you have an accident as the law clearly states that you must isolate the scene of an accident until it is inspected or released by an Inspector. Section 55 applies.

Danger tags must also be used when you lock out a machine for maintenance or repair from time to time. The danger tag must state the name of the manager issuing it and how long it is to stand in place for.

60% OF CONSTRUCTION DEATHS IN THE USA (OSHA)

According to [OSHA](#), 20% of all fatalities in private industry were related to construction in 2017. Of these deaths, nearly 60% were caused by four events, known in the industry as *The Fatal Four*

1. **Falls:** 39% of deaths in construction
2. **Struck by Object:** 8% of deaths in construction
3. **Electrocutions:** 7% of deaths in construction
4. **Caught in or between:** 5% of deaths in construction
